16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

19 10-618.

20 (a) Unless otherwise provided by law, if a custodian believes that inspection of

- 21 a part of a public record by the applicant would be contrary to the public interest, the
- 22 custodian may deny inspection by the applicant of that part, as provided in this

23 section.

24 (J) A CUSTODIAN MAY DENY INSPECTION OF A PUBLIC RECORD THAT 25 CONTAINS INFORMATION DISCLOSING OR RELATING TO PUBLIC SECURITY IF THE

1 CUSTODIAN DETERMINES THAT INSPECTION OF THE INFORMATION WOULD 2 CONSTITUTE A RISK TO THE PUBLIC OR TO PUBLIC SECURITY.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 4 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,

5 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members

6 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from

7 the date it is enacted.
