- 1 (f) (1) Each recipient of a scholarship under this section may hold the award 2 for 5 years of full-time study or 8 years of part-time study.
- 3 (2) The Administration may not award more than 15 scholarships 4 annually under subsection (d)(7) of this section.
- 5 (g) The Commission:
- 6 (1) May accept any gift or grant from any person for the Edward T. 7 Conroy Scholarship Fund;
- 8 (2) Shall use any gift or grant that it receives for a scholarship from the 9 Program; and
- 10 (3) Shall deposit any gift or grant that it receives for the Program with 11 the State Treasurer in a nonbudgeted account.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 July 1, 2002.
