2 Vehicle Laws - Parking Citations - Late Fees and Notification

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain State agencies and political subdivisions that
- 4 issue parking citations from imposing late fees in connection with parking
- 5 citations not timely paid until the payment is more than a certain number of
- 6 days late; prohibiting certain State agencies and political subdivisions from
- 7 notifying the Motor Vehicle Administration that a parking citation has not been
- 8 paid until the payment is more than a certain number of days late; defining a
- 9 certain term; and generally relating to late fees for parking citations issued by
- 10 State agencies and political subdivisions.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Transportation
- 19 26-307.
- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LATE FEE" MEANS ANY CHARGE OR FEE IMPOSED
- 21 BECAUSE A PAYMENT IS NOT MADE WHEN THE PAYMENT IS DUE UNDER THE TERMS
- 22 OF A PARKING CITATION ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, INCLUDING A FEE THAT IS
- 23 DESCRIBED:
- 24 (1) AS A FLAT RATE:
- 25 (2) AS A PERCENTAGE OF THE AMOUNT DUE; OR
- 26 (3) IN ANY OTHER TERMS.

- 1 (B) A STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE
- 2 PARKING CITATIONS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT CHARGE A LATE FEE UNTIL
- 3 THE PARKING CITATION IS MORE THAN 30 DAYS LATE.
- 4 (C) A STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION MAY NOT NOTIFY THE
- 5 ADMINISTRATION THAT A PERSON HAS FAILED TO PAY A PARKING CITATION UNTIL
- 6 THE PARKING CITATION IS MORE THAN 60 DAYS LATE.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 8 effect October 1, 2002.
