SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

9 26-307.
20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LATE FEE" MEANS ANY CHARGE OR FEE IMPOSED 21 BECAUSE A PAYMENT IS NOT MADE WHEN THE PAYMENT IS DUE UNDER THE TERMS OF A PARKING CITATION ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, INCLUDING A FEE THAT IS DESCRIBED:
(1) AS A FLAT RATE;
(2) AS A PERCENTAGE OF THE AMOUNT DUE; OR
(3) IN ANY OTHER TERMS.

1 3 THE PARKING CITATION IS MORE THAN 30 DAYS LATE.

4 (C) A STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION MAY NOT NOTIFY THE 5 ADMINISTRATION THAT A PERSON HAS FAILED TO PAY A PARKING CITATION UNTIL 6 THE PARKING CITATION IS MORE THAN 60 DAYS LATE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 8 effect October 1, 2002.
