1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County - County Officials - Salaries**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the County Commissioners of Calvert
4 County, Calvert County Treasurer, Sheriff of Calvert County, and Orphans'
5 Court Judges for Calvert County; providing that this Act does not apply to the
6 salary or compensation of the incumbent County Commissioners of Calvert
7 County, Calvert County Treasurer, Sheriff of Calvert County, or Orphans' Court
8 Judges for Calvert County; and generally relating to the salaries of certain
9 Calvert County officials.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 **Article 5 - Calvert County**

12 2-101.

13 (A) Five county commissioners comprise the Board of County Commissioners
14 of Calvert County.

15 (B) (1) The annual salary of the president of the board is [\$32,500, and the]:

16 (I) \$37,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002;

17 (II) \$38,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2003;

18 (III) \$39,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2004; AND

19 (IV) \$40,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT
20 CALENDAR YEAR.

21 (2) THE annual salary of each of the associate members of the board is
22 [\$30,000]:

23 (I) \$35,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002;

24 (II) \$36,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2003;

25 (III) \$37,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2004; AND

26 (IV) \$38,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT
27 CALENDAR YEAR.

28 (C) Each commissioner may be reimbursed up to an annual total of \$2,000, for
29 any reasonable costs incurred by the commissioner in carrying out the functions of the
30 office.

4 salary of [\$37,000]:

5 (I) \$44,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002;

6 (II) \$44,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2003;

7 (III) \$45,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2004; AND

8 (IV) \$45,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT

12 (f) (1) The Sheriff of Calvert County shall receive an annual salary of
13 [\$51,000]:

14 (I) \$57,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002;

15 (II) \$59,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2003;

16 (III) \$62,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2004; AND

17 (IV) \$64,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT
18 CALENDAR YEAR.19 **Article - Estates and Trusts**

21 (f) (1) Each of the judges of the Court for Calvert County shall receive as
22 annual compensation the sum of [\$5,000]:

23 (I) \$7,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002;

24 (II) \$7,250 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2003;

25 (III) \$7,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2004; AND

26 (IV) \$7,750 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT
27 CALENDAR YEAR.

28 (2) The salary of the Chief Judge is [\$5,200]:

29 (I) \$7,200 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2002;

- 1 (II) \$7,450 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2003;
2 (III) \$7,700 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2004; AND
3 (IV) \$7,950 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT
4 CALENDAR YEAR.

5 (3) The County Commissioners may provide additional funds for
6 expenses for the judges.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
8 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
9 apply to the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners of Calvert County,
10 Calvert County Treasurer, Sheriff of Calvert County, or Orphans' Court Judges for
11 Calvert County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act
12 concerning the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners of Calvert
13 County, Calvert County Treasurer, Sheriff of Calvert County, or Orphans' Court
14 Judges for Calvert County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term
15 of office.

16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2002.
