17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article 11 - Frederick County 2 2-2-21.1. 3 (b) (3) In Frederick County, the board of county commissioners may (i) 4 also negotiate with Frederick Memorial Hospital, Inc. in the same manner in which 5 the board of county commissioners may negotiate with any governmental body or 6 agency located within the county for the sale of real property no longer needed by the 7 county school board. 8 In Frederick County, the board of county commissioners may (ii) 9 accept gifts of land not needed for public purposes and sell the property at public or 10 private sale for such consideration as the board considers adequate.
