3 FOR the purpose of including Allegany County in the counties in which it is a

4 misdemeanor for a person to give, direct, or perform a live obscene performance

5 in the presence of individuals who have paid consideration to observe the

6 performance, or for certain persons knowingly to permit the live obscene

7 performance in certain premises participate in a certain manner in certain

8 obscene live performances or for certain persons associated with certain

9 premises to allow or assent to the use of the premises for certain live obscene

10 performances under certain circumstances; making this Act an emergency

11 *measure*; and generally relating to the prohibition against obscene performances

12 in certain counties.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (a) Any person who as actor, dancer, owner, manager, producer, director or

19 agent or in any other capacity, prepares, gives, directs, presents, performs or

20 participates in any obscene performance, exhibition, drama, play, show, dancing

21 exhibition, tableau, or entertainment in which live persons perform or participate in an

22 obscene manner in the presence of any other person or persons who have paid a

23 consideration of any type whatsoever to observe the exhibition or performance shall be

24 guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined or imprisoned according to

25 the penalty set forth under § 424 of this article.

26 (b) Every owner, lessee, or manager of any theatre, garden, building, room,

27 place or structure, who knowingly permits the same to be used for the purpose of any

28 such exhibition as enumerated in paragraph (a) of this section, or who assents to its

29 use for any such purpose shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be

30 *fined or imprisoned according to the penalty set forth under § 424 of this article.*

3 4	(a) This section applies only in ALLEGANY, Anne Arundel, Charles, Howard, Somerset, Wicomico, and Worcester counties.
7 8	(b) (1) A person may not prepare, give, direct, present, perform or participate in an obscene performance, exhibition, drama, play, show, dancing exhibition, tableau, or other entertainment in which individuals perform or participate live in an obscene manner in the presence of individuals who have paid any kind of consideration to observe the exhibition or performance.
	(2) An owner, lessee, or manager of a building, garden, place, room, structure, or theater may not knowingly allow or assent to the use of the premises for the types of exhibitions prohibited by paragraph (1) of this subsection.
13 14	(c) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:
15 16	(1) for a first violation, imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both; and
17 18	(2) for each subsequent violation, imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or both.
19 20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
23	<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall</u> take effect on the taking effect of Chapter (H.B. 11) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002. If Section 2 of this Act takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
27 28	<u>SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency</u> measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly and, except as provided in Section 3 of this Act, shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
