- 3 (1) THE vehicle bears a special registration plate, a removable
- 4 windshield placard, or a temporary removable windshield placard issued by the
- 5 Administration under § 13-616, § 13-616.1, or § 13-616.2 of this article or similarly
- 6 by another state, the District of Columbia, or another country; AND
- 7 (2) THE PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO USE THE PRIVILEGES CONFERRED
