20	(2)	Upon approval of the application:	
	(i) A Class 1 wholesale licensee may use additional locations for 2 the warehousing, sale and delivery of beer, wine and liquor upon the payment of an 3 additional fee of \$2,000 for each additional location.

- 1 (ii) A Class 2 wholesale licensee may use additional locations for 2 the warehousing, sale and delivery of wine and liquor upon the payment of an 3 additional fee of \$1,750 for each additional location. 4 (iii) A Class 3 wholesale licensee may use additional locations for 5 the warehousing, sale and delivery of beer and wine upon the payment of an 6 additional fee of \$1,500 for each additional location. 7 A Class 4 wholesale licensee may use additional locations for (iv) 8 the warehousing, sale and delivery of beer upon the payment of an additional fee of 9 \$1,250 for each additional location. 10 A Class 5 wholesale licensee may use additional locations for 11 the warehousing, sale and delivery of wine upon the payment of an additional fee of 12 \$1,250 for each additional location. 13 [(3)]Two locations under one license may not be located in any one county 14 or in Baltimore City.]
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 July 1, 2002.
