- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 7 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 8 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Kent County in office
- 9 on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
- 10 compensation of the State's Attorney for Kent County shall take effect at the
- 11 beginning of the next following term of office.
- 12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 2002.
