- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 18 24-406.
- 19 (a) A member may be entitled to benefits under Title 29 of this article other
- 20 than, or in addition to, the service retirement benefits provided under this subtitle.
- 21 (b) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS:
- 22 (I) RECEIVING A SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OR A VESTED
- 23 ALLOWANCE FROM THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND
- 24 (II) SERVING AS A SHERIFF OR STATE'S ATTORNEY FOR A COUNTY
- 25 THAT IS A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT.
- 26 (2) A member is not entitled to receive a pension or retirement allowance
- 27 from another pension or retirement system supported wholly or in part by the State.

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 2 construed retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect any
  3 individual who was serving as a sheriff or State's Attorney on or after January 4, 1999
- 4 and is serving in that same position on July 1, 2002.
- 5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 July 1, 2002.
