- 4 that certain children wear a certain mouthguard during a certain time;

- 6 participants wear a mouthguard; providing for a waiver process to exempt
- 7 certain children from wearing a mouthguard under certain circumstances;
- 8 requiring the waiver form to be approved by the sponsoring entity of the sports
