1 (1) IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 30 DAYS OR A FINE 2 NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH; AND

- 3 (2) SHALL PAY THE COST OF REPAIRS.
