

- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

27 (a) The provisions of this section apply only in Frederick County.



- 9 (II) CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR (ON-SALE) LICENSES IF THE 10 LICENSED PREMISES DERIVE AT LEAST 70% OF ITS MONTHLY GROSS REVENUE FROM 11 THE SALE OF FOOD.
- 12 (2) IN ALL OTHER AREAS OF THE MIDDLETOWN (3RD) ELECTION
 13 DISTRICT, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ONLY ISSUE CLASS A, B, OR
 14 C BEER LICENSES.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 July 1, 2002.
