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Environment - Wastewater Treatment Facilities - Notice of Discharges

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to impose certain

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
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Article - Environment

20 9-301.

21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

22 (b) "Board" means the Water Science Advisory Board.

23 (c) "COMBINED SEWER SYSTEM" MEANS A WASTEWATER COLLECTION 24 SYSTEM DESIGNED TO CARRY SANITARY SEWAGE AND STORMWATER IN A SINGLE 25 PIPE TO A TREATMENT FACILITY.

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1 (D) "Discharge permit" means a permit issued by the Department for the 2 discharge of any pollutant or combination of pollutants into the waters of this State.

3 [(d)] (E) "Person" includes the federal government, this State, any county, 4 municipal corporation, or other political subdivision of this State, or any of their 5 units.

6 (F) "POINT OF DISCHARGE" MEANS THAT LOCATION IN OR ADJACENT TO A 7 BODY OF WATER AT WHICH ANY MIXTURE OF LIQUID AND OTHER MATERIALS IS 8 DISCHARGED OR DEPOSITED.

9 [(e)] (G) "Sewage" means any human or animal excretion, domestic waste, or 10 industrial waste.

11 [(f)] (H) (1) "Sewerage system" means:

12 (i) The channels used or intended to be used to collect and dispose 13 of sewage; and

14 (ii) Any structure and appurtenance used or intended to be used to 15 collect or prepare sewage for discharge into the waters of this State.

16 (2) "Sewerage system" includes any sewer of any size.

17 (3) "Sewerage system" does not include the plumbing system inside any18 building served by the sewerage system.

20 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPOSE AS A CONDITION FOR ALL 21 DISCHARGE PERMITS THAT THE PERMIT HOLDER POST PERMANENT SIGNAGE THAT 22 INCLUDES:

23 (I) THE NAME OF THE PERMITTED FACILITY;

24 (II) THE PERMIT NUMBER;

25 (III) THE POINTS OF DISCHARGE OR OUTFALL NUMBER; AND

26 (IV) A WARNING REGARDING THE NATURE OF THE DISCHARGE.

27 (2) THE WARNING REQUIRED BY SUBPARAGRAPH (C)(1)(IV) OF THIS
28 SECTION SHALL STATE:

29 (I) FOR A WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, "NOTICE - THIS IS 30 A WASTEWATER DISCHARGE POINT";

31(II)FOR A COMBINED SEWER SYSTEM, "WARNING - THIS IS A32COMBINED STORMWATER SEWAGE OUTFALL"; AND

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1 (III) FOR A WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM THAT HAS A 2 DESIGNED, PERMANENT OVERFLOW POINT PRIOR TO REACHING A TREATMENT 3 PLANT, "WARNING - THIS IS A SANITARY SEWAGE OVERFLOW DISCHARGE POINT". 4 THE SIGNAGE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE (3)5 POSTED AT EACH: (I) POINT OF DISCHARGE; AND 6 POINT AT WHICH THE DISCHARGE ENTERS INTO OR ONTO 7 (II)8 PROPERTY NOT OWNED BY THE PERMIT HOLDER, IF DIFFERENT FROM THE POINT OF 9 DISCHARGE. 10 (4) THE SIGNAGE SHALL BE: 11 (I) AT LEAST 3 FEET ABOVE GROUND LEVEL; AND 12 (II) CLEARLY VISIBLE TO PERSONS ON THE ADJOINING PROPERTY 13 AND WATERS. THE LETTERING ON THE SIGNAGE SHALL CONFORM TO THE 14 (5)15 FOLLOWING SIZE REQUIREMENTS: (I) THE WORDS "NOTICE" AND "WARNING" SHALL BE AT LEAST 3 16 17 INCHES TALL; AND 18 (II) THE REMAINING WORDS SHALL BE AT LEAST 2 1/4 INCHES 19 TALL.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

21 October 1, 2002.

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
