2 State Board of Morticians - Sunset Extension and Program Evaluation

- 3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Morticians in accordance with the
- 4 provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by extending
- 5 to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and
- 6 regulatory authority of the Board; clarifying a certain inspection policy;
- 7 requiring that an evaluation of the Board and the statutes and regulations that
- 8 relate to the Board be performed on or before a certain date; requiring the Board
- 9 to submit a certain report by a certain date; and generally relating to the State
- 10 Board of Morticians.

- 26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article - Health Occupations

- 3 (A) All inspections of funeral establishments shall be unannounced AND MAY
- 4 TAKE PLACE AT ANY TIME WITHOUT NOTICE FROM THE BOARD.
- 5 (B) AN UNANNOUNCED INSPECTION MAY INCLUDE ADVANCE NOTICE THAT
- 6 AN INVESTIGATOR MAY BE IN THE REGION OF THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT, IF:
- 7 (1) THE ADVANCE NOTICE IS NO MORE THAN 14 DAYS PRIOR TO THE 8 INSPECTION:
- 9 (2) NO SPECIFIC DATE OR TIME IS PROVIDED FOR THE INSPECTION; AND
- 10 (3) THE ADVANCE NOTICE IS PROVIDED SOLELY TO ENSURE THAT A 11 LICENSED MORTICIAN WILL BE ON SITE FOR THE INSPECTION.

- Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program
- 14 Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall

- 19 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a
- 20 preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this

- 22 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before
- 23 the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation
- 24 shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and
- 25 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:
- 26 (41) Morticians, State Board of (§ 7-201 of the Health Occupations
- 27 Article: July 1, [2001] 2006);
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Board of
- 29 Morticians shall report to the General Assembly on or before October 1, 2002, in
- 30 accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the implementation
- 31 status of nonstatutory recommendations made by the Department of Legislative
- 32 Services that are adopted by the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental
- 33 Affairs Committee and the House Environmental Matters Committee.
- 34 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 35 June 1, 2002.
