# A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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### **Education - Maryland Public School Supplemental Fund**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Maryland Public School Supplemental Fund to

4 assist the counties in the State to fund the operations of the public schools in the

- 5 respective counties for teacher retention and recruitment; establishing a
- 6 funding mechanism for the Fund; establishing procedures for holding moneys in
- 7 the Fund; requiring the State Board of Education to administer the Fund;
- 8 establishing criteria for determining appropriations from the Fund; specifying
- 9 certain duties of the State Superintendent of Schools and the State Comptroller

10 under this Act; requiring the State Lottery Agency to deposit into the Fund the

11 proceeds, after certain expenses, of certain lotteries; requiring the State Lottery

12 Agency to conduct a certain number of education lotteries; requiring the State

13 Lottery Agency to meet certain advertising criteria in conducting the education

14 lotteries; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to establishing the

15 Maryland Public School Supplemental Fund.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article - Education**

10 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL 11 SUPPLEMENTAL FUND.

12 (B) IT IS THE POLICY OF THE STATE THAT THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS BE 13 ADEQUATELY FUNDED.

14 (C) THERE IS A MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL FUND 15 ESTABLISHED TO HELP CARRY OUT THIS POLICY.

16 (D) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO SUPPLEMENT COUNTY FUNDING FOR 17 TEACHER RETENTION AND RECRUITMENT.

18 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF THE PROFITS DERIVED FROM THE EDUCATION
19 LOTTERY CONDUCTED UNDER TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
20 ARTICLE.

21 (F) THE FUND IS:

22 (1) A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND; AND

23 (2) NOT SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND 24 PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

25 (G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY.

27 (I) ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND; AND

28 (II) DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND FOR USE BY THE STATE BOARD THE

24 (a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:

(1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the
expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this
subtitle and the State budget; and

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1 5-202.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, THE MONEY THAT REMAINS IN THE STATE 2 LOTTERY FUND FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE EDUCATION LOTTERY, AFTER THE 3 DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND 4 [(ii)] (III) into the General Fund of the State the money that 5 remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all other lotteries after the 6 distribution under subsection (a) of this section. The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is 7 (2)8 available in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery 9 Fund. 24 (A) DURING EACH FISCAL YEAR THE AGENCY SHALL CONDUCT AT LEAST ONE
25 EDUCATION LOTTERY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL
26 SUPPLEMENTAL FUND.

(B) IN ALL ADVERTISING AND ON ALL TICKETS, THE AGENCY SHALL IDENTIFY
28 EACH LOTTERY UNDER THIS SECTION AS BEING CONDUCTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF
29 THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL FUND.
