## A BILL ENTITLED

## 2 State Lottery - Unanticipated Revenues

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain unanticipated
- 4 lottery revenues to counties and municipal corporations for a certain purpose on

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article State Government
- 15 9-120.
- 16 (a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:
- 17 (1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the
- 18 expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this
- 19 subtitle and the State budget; and
- 20 (2) then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article and
- 21 § 11-618 of the Criminal Procedure Article, the holder of each winning ticket or share.
- 22 (b) (1) [Promptly] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
- 23 SECTION, PROMPTLY after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller shall pay:
- 24 (i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that
- 25 remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted
- 26 for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority, after the distribution under
- 27 subsection (a) of this section; and

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1 into the General Fund of the State the money that remains in (ii) 2 the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all other lotteries after the distribution 3 under subsection (a) of this section. 4 The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is 5 available in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery 6 Fund. 7 (C) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "UNANTICIPATED REVENUES" MEANS STATE (1) 8 LOTTERY REVENUES THAT EXCEED BUDGETARY PROJECTIONS FOR A FISCAL YEAR. IF THE STATE LOTTERY RECEIVES UNANTICIPATED REVENUES FOR (2) 10 A FISCAL YEAR, THE COMPTROLLER: (I) MAY NOT DISTRIBUTE INTO THE GENERAL FUND ANY OF THE 12 UNANTICIPATED REVENUES; AND 13 SHALL DISTRIBUTE TO EACH COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL (II)14 CORPORATION THE UNANTICIPATED REVENUES ON A PRO RATA BASIS ACCORDING 15 TO THE TOTAL LOTTERY SALES MADE IN EACH OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS. A COUNTY SHALL USE THE UNANTICIPATED REVENUES 16 17 DISTRIBUTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION ONLY FOR PUBLIC 18 EDUCATION. 19 (4) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE PRO RATA DISTRIBUTION TO POLITICAL 20 SUBDIVISIONS REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, LOTTERY 21 SALES MADE IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE 22 CALCULATION OF LOTTERY SALES FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE MUNICIPAL 23 CORPORATION IS LOCATED. 24 (D) The regulations of the Agency shall apportion the money in the State [(c)]25 Lottery Fund.
