- 1 ELECTRICIAN, THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION SHALL REPORT THE
- 2 DISCIPLINARY ACTION TO THE STATE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS OF COMMENCEMENT
- 3 OF THE ACTION.
- 4 (2) WHEN THE STATE BOARD RECEIVES NOTICE OF A LOCAL
- 5 DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST A LICENSED MASTER ELECTRICIAN, THE STATE
- 6 BOARD SHALL SEND WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE DISCIPLINARY ACTION TO EACH

- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Board of
- 28 Master Electricians shall report to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental
- 29 Affairs Committee and the House Economic Matters Committee on or before October
- 30 1, 2002, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the
- 31 implementation of recommendations of the Department of Legislative Services
- 32 contained in the sunset evaluation report dated October 2001.
