A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Caroline County - Alcoholic Beverages - Golf Course Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing in Caroline County a certain golf course alcoholic  
4 beverages license; establishing the terms, conditions, and fee for the golf course  
5 alcoholic beverages license and the hours and days allowed for the sale of  
6 alcoholic beverages under the license; and generally relating to alcoholic  
7 beverages in Caroline County.

8 BY adding to  
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 8-507.1  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2001 Replacement Volume)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 8-507.1.

17 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CAROLINE COUNTY.

18 (B) THERE IS A CLASS GC 7-DAY (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR  
19 LICENSE.

20 (C) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO A GOLF COURSE OR ORGANIZATION  
21 THAT:

- 22 (1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC;
- 23 (2) IS OPERATED FOR PROFIT;
- 24 (3) OWNS REAL ESTATE IN THE COUNTY; AND
- 25 (4) HAS A GOLF COURSE WITH A MINIMUM OF 18 HOLES.

1 (D) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,600.

2 (E) THE LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION  
3 ONLY ON THE LAND AND IN THE BUILDINGS, INCLUDING THE CLUBHOUSE, USED  
4 FOR GOLFING PURPOSES.

5 (F) A PATRON NEED NOT BE SEATED TO BE SERVED.

6 (G) THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR SALE ARE AS SPECIFIED IN § 11-506 OF THIS  
7 ARTICLE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 July 1, 2002.
