A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County - Board of Education - Districts**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that the membership of the Anne Arundel County  
4 Board of Education shall be based on the legislative districts as those districts  
5 existed on January 1, 2002; making this Act an emergency measure; and  
6 generally relating to the Anne Arundel County Board of Education districts.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article - Education  
9 Section 3-110  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2001 Replacement Volume)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 3-110.

16 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be  
17 appointed as follows:

18 (1) 3 from the county at large;

19 (2) 1 each from Legislative Districts 31, 32, and 33, AS EACH DISTRICT  
20 EXISTED ON JANUARY 1, 2002;

21 (3) 1 from Legislative District 27B (Anne Arundel County Election  
22 District 7; Precincts 1, 2, and 9) or District 30, AS EACH DISTRICT EXISTED ON  
23 JANUARY 1, 2002; and

24 (4) 1 student member.

25 (b) (1) The student member shall:

1 (i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character  
2 and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;

3 (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by  
4 the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County;

5 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and

6 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is  
7 appointed and qualifies.

8 (2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the  
9 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student  
10 Councils shall:

11 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and

12 (ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous  
13 student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.

14 (c) A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification shall  
15 be replaced as a member.

16 (d) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent member  
17 of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the legislative  
18 district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an  
20 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health  
21 or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the  
22 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take  
23 effect from the date it is enacted.
