BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Education** 15 3-110. The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be 17 appointed as follows: 18 (1) 3 from the county at large; 19 1 each from Legislative Districts 31, 32, and 33, AS EACH DISTRICT (2) 20 EXISTED ON JANUARY 1, 2002; 1 from Legislative District 27B (Anne Arundel County Election 21 22 District 7; Precincts 1, 2, and 9) or District 30, AS EACH DISTRICT EXISTED ON 23 JANUARY 1, 2002; and

- 1 Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character 2 and in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school; (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by 4 the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County; 5 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is 6 7 appointed and qualifies. 8 If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the 9 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student 10 Councils shall: 11 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and 12 (ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous 13 student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy. 14 A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification shall 15 be replaced as a member. If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent member 16 of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the legislative 17 18 district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
- 20 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
- 21 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
- 22 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
- 23 effect from the date it is enacted.
