- 1 (B) (C) (1) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR 2 BALTIMORE COUNTY SHALL ESTABLISH STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE 3 APPLICATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO A PARTICULAR TRANSACTION.
 4 (2) THE STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES SHALL REQUIRE:
- 5 (I) THE OFFICE, DIVISION, OR DEPARTMENT REQUESTING 6 NONCOMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION TO SUBMIT A WRITTEN JUSTIFICATION TO THE 7 DIRECTOR OF PURCHASING;
- 8 (II) A WRITTEN DETERMINATION BY THE DIRECTOR OF 9 PURCHASING THAT NONCOMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF 10 THE COLLEGE AND THE STATE; AND
- 11 (III) THE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT 12 ON THE BASIS OF NONCOMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2002.
