4 FOR the purpose of requiring each lavatory in a public school to contain soap for
5 washing hands; and generally relating to health and hygiene in public schools.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Education**

14 7-420.

15 EACH LAVATORY IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL CONTAIN SOAP FOR WASHING
16 HANDS.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
18 effect July 1, 2002.
