- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

20 6-301.

- 21 (y) (1) This subsection applies only in Worcester County.
- 22 (8) (I) Every licensee shall purchase all wines and liquors, except light
- 23 wine and beer, sold by them from the Worcester County Liquor Control Board
- 24 dispensaries. [The licensee shall receive a 15 percent discount from the retail sales
- 25 price or any special sale price or discount price, whichever is lower. However, the price
- 26 the Board charges to the licensees may not be lower than 10 percent above the cost
- 27 the Liquor Control Board must pay for the merchandise to wholesalers.]

- 1 (II) THE PRICE THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD CHARGES TO THE
- 2 LICENSEES FOR SPIRITS SHALL BE AT LEAST 10% ABOVE THE STANDARD BOTTLE
- 3 PRICE DETERMINED BY THE CURRENT EDITION OF THE MARYLAND BEVERAGE
- 4 JOURNAL BUT MAY NOT EXCEED 20% ABOVE THAT PRICE.
- 5 (III) THE STANDARD BOTTLE PRICE IS THE PRICE BEFORE A
- 6 DISCOUNT IS APPLIED.
- 7 (IV) All licensees may purchase beer and light wine from licensed
- 8 wholesalers.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2002.
