FOR the purpose of authorizing establishing that the County Commissioners of  Dorchester County to may impose civil penalties for violations of county animal control ordinances; authorizing the County Commissioners to provide for the  prosecution of a violation of a certain county animal control ordinance in a  certain manner and to a certain extent; and generally relating to animal control violation penalties in Dorchester County.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 1 Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions 2 11-504. 3 (o) (1)<u>(1)</u> In addition to and not in substitution for any powers granted 4 under this subtitle, the county commissioners of Dorchester, Garrett, and Somerset 5 counties may by ordinance provide for a comprehensive system for the regulation of 6 dogs and cats within the county, including licensing and control. These regulations 7 may include provision for the impounding and disposal of unlicensed or dangerous 8 dogs and cats and penalties, INCLUDING IN DORCHESTER COUNTY CIVIL OR 9 CRIMINAL PENALTIES, for violations of any of the provisions of the regulations. IN DORCHESTER COUNTY, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY 10 <u>(2)</u> 11 PROVIDE THAT A VIOLATION OF A COUNTY DOG OR CAT CONTROL ORDINANCE 12 SHALL BE PROSECUTED BY THE COUNTY IN THE SAME MANNER AND TO THE SAME

- 15 IN DORCHESTER COUNTY, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY, BY (2)
