- 15 (o) (1) In addition to and not in substitution for any powers granted under
- 16 this subtitle, the county commissioners of Dorchester, Garrett, and Somerset counties
- 17 may by ordinance provide for a comprehensive system for the regulation of dogs and
- 18 cats within the county, including licensing and control. These regulations may include
- 19 provision for the impounding and disposal of unlicensed or dangerous dogs and cats
- 20 and penalties for violations of any of the provisions of the regulations.
