23	(1) (i) The State's Attorney's annual salary shall be:
24	1. \$107,775 for calendar year 1999;
25	2. \$107,775 for calendar year 2000;

- 31 The deputy State's Attorneys and the assistant State's Attorneys (6)
- 32 shall perform whatever work as may be directed by the State's Attorney, or as
- 33 authorized by law, and under the direction of the State's Attorney may present cases
- 34 to the grand juries, sign indictments and criminal informations, and perform
- 35 whatever other acts and duties in relation to the grand juries and in the operation of
- 36 the office as are necessary and proper.

- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 10 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 11 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Prince George's County
- 12 in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
- 13 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Prince George's County shall take
- 14 effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
- 15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2002.
