- 26 (1) THE ATTENDANCE AND TESTIMONY OF A WITNESS; AND

- 13 (2) FAILURE OF A PERSON TO OBEY AN ORDER OF COURT ISSUED
- 14 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE PUNISHED AS CONTEMPT OF COURT.

- 16 October 1, 2002.
