1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 53(b)(3) through (7), respectively, of Article 87 - Sheriffs
3 of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 53(b)(4) through
4 (8), respectively.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
6 read as follows:

7 **Article 87 - Sheriffs**

9 (b) (2) Twelve members of each fire company may be designated by the
10 captain, chief, or other commanding officer of the fire companies in [the counties
11 listed in paragraph (1) of this subsection] ALLEGANY COUNTY, CARROLL COUNTY,
12 FREDERICK COUNTY, HARFORD COUNTY, KENT COUNTY, SOMERSET COUNTY,
13 WICOMICO COUNTY, AND WORCESTER COUNTY and recommended to be appointed
14 deputy sheriffs by the sheriff of the respective county.

15 (3) IN CECIL COUNTY, TWENTY MEMBERS OF EACH FIRE COMPANY MAY
16 BE DESIGNATED BY THE CAPTAIN, CHIEF, OR OTHER COMMANDING OFFICER OF THE
17 FIRE COMPANY AND RECOMMENDED TO BE APPOINTED AS DEPUTY SHERIFFS BY
18 THE CECIL COUNTY SHERIFF.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2002.
