3 FOR the purpose of requiring each public school in the State to conduct an indoor air

4 quality inspection each year to comply with certain guidelines; requiring the

6 <u>Environment</u>, to create and distribute an indoor air quality standards guide that

7 includes certain information; requiring each public school to submit an indoor

8 air quality inspection report to the county board of education each year;

9 requiring each county board of education to submit an indoor air quality

10 inspection report to the State Board of Education each year; requiring each

11 county board of education to develop a system of monitoring indoor air quality

for each school under the county board's jurisdiction using certain guidelines;
