A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2	Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Community Crisis

 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Community Crisis Services, Inc. for certain development or improvement

8 requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund in the

9 amount of \$100,000; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds

10 evidencing the loan.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That:

13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
15 George's County - Community Crisis Services Loan of 2002 in the total principal

16 amount of \$300,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of

17 State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public

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18 Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of

19 the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of Community
Crisis Services, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the
acquisition, repair, renovation, and capital equipping of a property located at 4316

31 Farragut Street in Hyattsville, to be used as the headquarters for a telephone based

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crisis center serving Prince George's, Montgomery, Charles, Calvert, St. Mary's, and
 Anne Arundel counties.

3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

7 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the 8 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a 9 matching fund of \$100,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, 10 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or 11 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind 12 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any 13 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify 14 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the 15 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2004, to present evidence 16 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If 17 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State 18 Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in 19 this Act.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 June 1, 2002.
