A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Board of Education - Compensation**
3 **MC 204-02**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the compensation received by elected members of the
5 Montgomery County Board of Education; repealing certain obsolete provisions;
6 providing certain benefits to elected members of the Board; establishing a
7 certain scholarship for a student member of the Board who fulfills a certain
8 requirement; and generally relating to the Montgomery County Board of
9 Education.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Education**

18 3-902.

19 (a) An elected member of the County Board [who is serving a term of office
20 that began before November 30, 1978 may not receive compensation for his services
21 but] is entitled to [an allowance of \$6,000 annually or any larger sum]
22 REIMBURSEMENT for travel and other expenses as provided by the Montgomery
23 County Council.

24 (b) (1) An elected member of the County Board [whose current full term of
25 office began on or after November 30, 1986] is entitled to receive [\$12,000] \$18,500
26 annually as compensation [instead of allowances] and the President of the County
27 Board [if entitled to compensation under this subsection] is entitled to an additional
28 [\$2,000] \$4,000 annually as compensation.

1 (2) [A member receiving annual compensation also is entitled to
2 reimbursement for expenses as approved by the Montgomery County Council.] AN
3 ELECTED MEMBER IS ENTITLED TO HEALTH INSURANCE AND TO OTHER FRINGE
4 BENEFITS REGULARLY PROVIDED TO EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

5 (c) (1) The student member may not receive compensation but, after
6 submitting expense vouchers, may be [reimbursed, but only] REIMBURSED for
7 out-of-pocket expenses incurred in connection with official duties.

8 (2) A STUDENT MEMBER WHO COMPLETES A FULL TERM ON THE BOARD
9 SHALL BE GRANTED A SCHOLARSHIP OF \$5,000 TO BE APPLIED TOWARD THE
10 STUDENT'S HIGHER EDUCATION COSTS.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2002.
