21 22	(IV) A LICENSEE MAY KEEP FOR SALE AND SELL AT RETAIL TO ANY CUSTOMER A MEMBER OR A GUEST WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR, PURCHASED FROM THE <u>DEPARTMENT OF</u> LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES ONLY.

24 (V) A LICENSE APPLICATION SHALL BE SIGNED BY AT LEAST ONE 25 OFFICER OF THE CLUB WHO IS A RESIDENT OF, REGISTERED VOTER IN, OR 26 TAYDAVED OF THE COUNTY
