## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Location of Licensed Premises 3 MC 211-02

- 4 FOR the purpose of substituting a certain zoning classification used in the City of
- 5 Rockville for one used elsewhere in Montgomery County to describe the area in
- 6 which a restaurant with a certain Class B (hotel-restaurant or hotel-motel)
- beer, wine and liquor on-sale only license may be located; and generally relating
- 8 to alcoholic beverages licenses in Montgomery County.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
- 10 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 11 Section 9-102.1(a), (b)(1) and (4), and (c)

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 22 9-102.1.
- 23 (a) This section applies only in Montgomery County.
- 24 (b) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 25 (4) "License" means a Class B beer, wine and liquor on-sale only license.

- 1 (c) After making an application and paying the fees, the holder of an original 2 license may obtain the additional license or licenses authorized by this section.
- 3 (g) (1) A licensee may obtain one additional license for premises which meet 4 the qualifications specified in this subsection. For identification purposes, this
- 5 additional license may be referred to as a "Rockville" license.
- 6 (2) The restaurant shall be located within [CBD zoned property within 7 the Rockville Town Center mixed use district] THE ROCKVILLE TOWN CENTER ZONED
- 8 PROPERTY.
- 9 (3) The requirement that the holder have been a licensee for 1 year does 10 not apply to this subsection.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 12 effect July 1, 2002.
