- 2 Natural Resources Hunting Licenses Nonresident Fees and Reversion of Fees to General Fund
- 4 FOR the purpose of altering the fees for certain nonresident hunting licenses;
- 5 requiring that certain unspent and unencumbered fees revert to the General
- 6 Fund; and generally relating to certain fees for certain nonresident hunting
- 7 licenses and the reversion of certain fees to the General Fund.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 1 Article - Natural Resources 2 10-301. 3 (f) (1) There shall be the following types of hunting licenses in the State: 4 A resident consolidated hunting license that enables the purchaser to hunt all legal game birds and mammals during any appropriate season 6 in Maryland without the purchase of additional stamps, except that to hunt wild 7 waterfowl the purchaser must also buy a Maryland migratory wild waterfowl stamp 8 and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp. 9 (ii) A resident basic hunting license that enables the purchaser to 10 hunt all legal game birds and mammals during any appropriate season without the 11 purchase of additional stamps unless the purchaser is hunting deer or wild waterfowl. 12 This license enables the purchaser to hunt deer only with the purchase of the 13 appropriate deer stamps and to hunt wild waterfowl only with the purchase of a 14 Maryland migratory wild waterfowl stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and 15 conservation stamp. 16 A nonresident basic hunting license that enables the purchaser (iii) 17 to hunt all legal game birds and mammals during any appropriate season without the 18 purchase of additional stamps unless the purchaser is hunting wild waterfowl or deer 19 during bow and arrow season or black powder season. This license enables the 20 purchaser to hunt wild waterfowl only with the purchase of a Maryland migratory 21 wild waterfowl stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp. 22 This license enables the purchaser to hunt deer during bow and arrow season and 23 black powder season only with the purchase of the appropriate deer stamp. 24 (iv) A nonresident 3-day hunting license that enables the purchaser 25 to hunt all legal game birds and mammals except deer and turkey for the 3 26 consecutive legal hunting days in a single season that are specified on the license by 27 the issuing agent. The purchaser must also purchase a Maryland migratory wild 28 waterfowl stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp to 29 hunt wild waterfowl with this license. Under no circumstance does this license 30 authorize the purchaser to hunt deer and turkey. Residents may purchase a senior consolidated license beginning in 32 the calendar year in which they attain the age of 65, which shall be valid for the 33 remainder of the purchaser's life. 34 Residents may purchase a senior consolidated annual license 35 beginning in the calendar year in which they attain the age of 65. (4) 36 A nonresident of any age must purchase either a nonresident basic 37 hunting license or a nonresident 3-day hunting license to hunt in the State. 38 (5) The fees for hunting licenses are according to the following schedule:
