- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20

- 7 (4) ANY OTHER EASEMENT HELD BY A FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL LAND 8 CONSERVATION OR HISTORIC PRESERVATION EASEMENT PROGRAM.

- 17 (2) POST NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ZONING CHANGE ON THE 18 PROPERTY TO WHICH THE PROPOSED ZONING CHANGE APPLIES.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2002.
