BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages** 6 7 6-201. This subsection applies only in Montgomery County. 8 (Q) (q) (1) (i) 9 (4) (I) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY" MEANS A 10 FACILITY THAT IS USED FOR ARTISTIC, CORPORATE, AND COMMUNITY RELATED 11 ACTIVITIES. 12 (II)THERE IS A MONTGOMERY COUNTY SPECIAL CLASS B-BWL 13 (PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE. 14 THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A (III)15 SPECIAL CLASS B-BWL (PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY) LICENSE TO APPLY ONLY TO A 16 PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY THAT HAS: 17 1. A MINIMUM CAPITAL INVESTMENT, NOT INCLUDING REAL 18 PROPERTY, OF \$1,000,000; 19 2. A MINIMUM CAPACITY OF 2,000 PERSONS; AND 20 3. A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY PERMIT AND 40 SEATS IN A 21 FOOD SERVICE AREA. 22 THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL CLASS B-BWL (PERFORMING 23 ARTS FACILITY) LICENSE FOR USE BY A NOT-FOR-PROFIT PARTNERSHIP, LIMITED 24 LIABILITY COMPANY, CORPORATION, OR OTHER ENTITY THAT LEASES THE 25 PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY TO HOST ARTISTIC, CORPORATE, AND COMMUNITY 26 RELATED ACTIVITIES. A SPECIAL CLASS B-BWL (PERFORMING ARTS FACILITY) 27 1. 28 LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR BY THE 29 DRINK FROM ONE OR MORE OUTLETS ON THE LICENSED PREMISES FOR 30 CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES. A HOLDER OF A SPECIAL CLASS B-BWL (PERFORMING 31 32 ARTS FACILITY) LICENSE MAY ONLY EXERCISE THE PRIVILEGES UNDER THE 33 LICENSE FROM 10:00 A.M. ON ANY DAY UNTIL 2:00 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY. 34 3.
