5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Montgomery County Board of License

6 Commissioners to issue a one-day special Class C beer license, beer and wine

7 license, or beer, wine and liquor license to certain community swimming pool

8 clubs; specifying certain criteria for swimming pool clubs regarding membership

9 and licensure; specifying hours during which the license may be exercised;

10 prohibiting with a certain exception persons under a certain age from attending

11 certain entertainments; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses

12 for <u>community</u> swimming pool clubs in Montgomery County.
