SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

- 3 (a) Each member of the Commission shall receive an annual salary of \$5,600
- 4 and the chairman shall receive \$6,100. In addition they shall be entitled to an annual
- 5 expense allowance of up to \$2,400, according to rules and regulations adopted by the
- 6 Commission, provided a voucher is submitted showing the expenses. All salaries are
- 7 to be payable monthly from the administrative tax collected by the Commission.
- 8 (b) In the discretion of the County Executive of Prince George's County,
- 9 subject to approval by the County Council by a vote of the majority of the full Council,
- 10 a member of the Commission from that county may be designated to serve on a
- 11 full-time basis, and this member may be either the chairman or the vice-chairman of
- 12 the Commission. The Montgomery County Council may designate a member of the
- 13 Commission from that county to serve on a full-time basis provided that person has
- 14 been designated by that county under the provisions of § 2-101 of this article to serve
- 15 as chairman or vice-chairman of the Commission. For any member designated by
- 16 Prince George's County to serve on a full-time basis, the County Council of that
- 17 county, upon recommendation from the County Executive, may authorize whatever
- 18 supplementary salary as may be deemed appropriate. For any member designated by
- 19 Montgomery County to serve on a full-time basis, the County Council, with approval
- 20 of the County Executive, may authorize whatever supplementary salary as may be
- 21 appropriate. In the event the County Executive fails to approve a supplementary
- 22 salary authorization by the Council within 30 days, the Council, by an affirmative
- 23 vote of 6 of its members, may authorize the supplementary salary notwithstanding
- 24 the lack of approval of the County Executive. Any supplementary salary authorized in
- 25 this title shall be payable also from the administrative tax collected by the
- 26 Commission.

- 28 (g) (1) Notwithstanding other provisions of this article, funds may be
- 29 included in the Commission's annual budget and appropriated by the respective
- 30 county governing bodies to provide an annual salary [of \$12,900] for each planning
- 31 board member, other than a full-time member, as compensation for the planning
- 32 board member's services.
- 33 (2) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE PRINCE GEORGE'S
- 34 COUNTY COUNCIL MAY EACH ESTABLISH THE SALARY FOR A PLANNING BOARD
- 35 MEMBER FROM THAT COUNTY, OTHER THAN A FULL-TIME MEMBER, BY COUNTY LAW
- 36 SEPARATE FROM BUDGET ACTION, AFTER NOTICE AND PUBLIC HEARING.
- 37 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 38 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 39 apply to the salary or compensation of the part-time members of the Montgomery
- 40 County planning board or the Prince George's County planning board in office on the
- 41 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
- 42 compensation of the part-time members of the Montgomery County planning board

- 1 or the Prince George's County planning board shall take effect at the beginning of the 2 next following term of office.
- 3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 June 1, 2002.
