15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

- 19 (a) A building or other structure may not be erected or structurally altered in 20 the regional district without the issuance of a building permit[, and a].
- 21 (B) (1) A permit may not be given except in conformity with the provisions of
- 22 this article and of the regulations enacted by the respective district councils.
- 23 (2) UNLESS THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT IS OPPOSED, A BUILDING
- 24 PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED WITHIN 14 DAYS AFTER ITS SUBMISSION.

- 1 (3) IF A PORTION OF A CONSTRUCTION PROJECT IS OPPOSED. A 2 BUILDING PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED WITHIN 14 DAYS AFTER ITS SUBMISSION FOR 3 THE PORTION OF THE PROJECT NOT OPPOSED.
- 4 A building permit is not required for buildings and structures to be used 5 exclusively for purposes of agriculture upon land used exclusively for agriculture.
- 6 In any part of the regional district in which there does not now exist (D) 7 provision of law or ordinance designating an administrative official by whom building 8 permits are to be issued, the appropriate district council shall designate this official.
- 9 (E) An act, ordinance, or regulation issued under the authority of this (1) 10 article does not require the approval by the Commission of any building permit in 11 Montgomery County or Prince George's [County, and] COUNTY.
- ANY [any] acts, ordinances, or regulations inconsistent [herewith] 13 WITH THIS SECTION are repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
- 14 [However, in] IN Montgomery County, all building permit (3) 15 applications shall be referred to the Commission for review and recommendations as 16 to zoning requirements.
- 17 In Prince George's County, the County Council may provide by 18 ordinance for the referral of some or all building permit applications to the
- 19 Commission for review and recommendations as to zoning requirements.
- 20 A district council may provide in its zoning regulations for the
- 21 issuance of use and occupancy permits and for certificates by means of which zoning
- 22 questions may be raised prior to the preparation of all structural specifications of a
- 23 building as may be required for a complete building permit.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 2002.
