- 15 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO DRILLS A WELL TO
- 16 CONDUCT TEMPORARY DEWATERING BY USE OF WELL POINTS, DEEP WELLS, OR
- 17 SIMILAR METHODS OF DEWATERING TO INSTALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES.
- (B) A person may not drill a well in this State unless the Department issues a
- 19 permit to drill the well.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 2002.
