- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 **Article - Insurance**
- 15 15-10B-06.
- A private review agent may not render an adverse decision as to an 16
- admission of a patient during the first [24] 72 hours after admission when:
- 18 the admission is based on a determination that the patient is in (1)
- 19 imminent danger to self or others;
- the determination has been made by the patient's physician or 20
- 21 psychologist in conjunction with a member of the medical staff of the facility who has
- 22 privileges to make the admission; and
- 23 (3) the hospital immediately notifies the private review agent of:
- 24 (i) the admission of the patient; and
- 25 the reasons for the admission. (ii)

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2002.
