- 22 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 2 and 4 of this
- 23 Act shall take effect October 1, 2000. [Sections 2 and 4 of this Act shall remain
- 24 effective for a period of 1 year and 9 months and, at the end of June 30, 2002, with no
- 25 further action required by the General Assembly, Sections 2 and 4 of this Act shall be
- 26 abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

## Chapter 423 of the Acts of 2001

- 2 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 3 October 1, 2001. [It shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination
- 4 provision specified in Section 5 of Chapter 275 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
- 5 2000. If that termination provision takes effect, this Act shall be abrogated and of no
- 6 further force and effect. This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that
- 7 termination provision.]

- 9 June 1, 2002.
