CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Milk Products - Length of Sell-by Period

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing requiring the Secretary of the Department of Health

4 and Mental Hygiene to establish the sell-by period, of up to a certain number of days, for certain milk products; and generally relating to the "sell-by period" of

HOUSE BILL 845

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1
- 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- **Article Health General** 3
- 4 21-426.
- In this section, "sell-by period" means the length of time a Grade A milk 5 (a) 6 product may be kept for sale.
- After a public hearing, the Secretary shall adopt rules and (1)
- 8 regulations that establish a method for conspicuously marking, on the Grade A milk
- 9 product container, the last date on which the product may be sold.
- Each Grade A milk product container shall be marked as required by 11 rules and regulations adopted under this subtitle.
- THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH THE SELL-BY PERIOD, OF UP TO 17 12
- 13 <u>DAYS</u>, FOR [A] A Grade A milk product that is cooled to, packaged, and stored at 45
- 14 degrees Fahrenheit or less before it is purchased by or delivered to the ultimate
- 15 consumer [has a sell-by period of 14 days].
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16
- 17 October 1, 2002.
