## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Milk Products - Length of Sell-by Period

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of the Department of Health and
- 4 Mental Hygiene to establish the sell-by period for certain milk products; and
- 5 generally relating to the "sell-by period" of milk products.
- 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 10 (2000 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Health General
- 14 21-426.
- 15 (a) In this section, "sell-by period" means the length of time a Grade A milk 16 product may be kept for sale.
- 17 (b) (1) After a public hearing, the Secretary shall adopt rules and
- 18 regulations that establish a method for conspicuously marking, on the Grade A milk
- 19 product container, the last date on which the product may be sold.
- 20 (2) Each Grade A milk product container shall be marked as required by
- 21 rules and regulations adopted under this subtitle.
- 22 (c) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH THE SELL-BY PERIOD FOR [A] A
- 23 Grade A milk product that is cooled to, packaged, and stored at 45 degrees Fahrenheit

- 1 or less before it is purchased by or delivered to the ultimate consumer [has a sell-by 2 period of 14 days].
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2002.
