## 2 Inmates - Mandatory Supervision Revocation - Diminution Credits

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that an inmate whose program of mandatory
- 4 supervision is revoked may not receive any diminution credits for the sentence
- 5 or sentences for which the inmate was awarded diminution credits before the
- 6 inmate's release on mandatory supervision; providing that an inmate whose
- 7 program of mandatory supervision from a term of confinement for the
- 8 commission and conviction of a crime of violence is revoked because of the
- 9 commission of another crime of violence may not be awarded diminution credits
- 10 for work tasks or for special projects for all of the new sentence whether the new
- sentence runs concurrently or consecutively to the sentence for which the
- inmate was awarded diminution credits before release on mandatory
- supervision; and generally relating to diminution credits for inmates under
- 14 mandatory supervision programs.

- 21 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services has
- 22 studied the issue of diminution of confinement credits and mandatory supervision
- 23 releases; and
- 24 WHEREAS, In January 2002, the Department issued its Report to the General
- 25 Assembly on Diminution of Confinement Credits and Mandatory Supervision
- 26 Releases: and
- 27 WHEREAS, One of the Department's recommendations is that the General
- 28 Assembly provide further guidance as it relates to the application of diminution of
- 29 confinement credits and mandatory supervision release; and

- WHEREAS, It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide clarification on
- 2 the policy of not awarding diminution credits in certain instances when an inmate's
- 3 mandatory supervision program is revoked; now, therefore,
- 4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 7-504.

- 8 (a) The commissioner presiding at an individual's mandatory supervision
- 9 revocation hearing may revoke any or all of the diminution credits previously earned
- 10 by the individual on the individual's term of confinement.
- 11 (b) An inmate may not be awarded any new diminution credits after the
- 12 inmate's mandatory supervision has been revoked FOR THE SENTENCE OR
- 13 SENTENCES FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL WAS AWARDED DIMINUTION CREDITS
- 14 BEFORE RELEASE ON MANDATORY SUPERVISION.
- 15 (C) AN INMATE WHO, WHILE ON MANDATORY SUPERVISION RELEASE FROM A
- 16 TERM OF CONFINEMENT FOR THE COMMISSION OF AND CONVICTION FOR A CRIME
- 17 LISTED UNDER § 14-101 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, COMMITS ANOTHER CRIME
- 18 LISTED UNDER § 14-101 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE FOR WHICH THE INMATE IS
- 19 CONVICTED AND SENTENCED MAY NOT BE AWARDED DIMINUTION CREDITS FOR
- 20 WORK TASKS UNDER § 3-705 OF THIS ARTICLE OR SPECIAL PROJECTS UNDER § 3-707
- 21 OF THIS ARTICLE FOR ALL OF THE NEW SENTENCE, WHETHER THE NEW SENTENCE
- 22 RUNS CONCURRENTLY OR CONSECUTIVELY TO THE SENTENCE FOR WHICH THE
- 23 INMATE WAS AWARDED DIMINUTION CREDITS BEFORE RELEASE ON MANDATORY
- 24 SUPERVISION.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2002.
