CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **University System of Maryland - Board of Regents**

3 FOR the purpose of adding the State Treasurer as an ex officio nonvoting member of
4 the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland; clarifying which
5 members of the Board of Regents are voting members; providing that the State
6 Treasurer is not subject to appointment by the Governor; providing that the
7 State Treasurer is not subject to a certain term limitation; and increasing the
8 total number of members of the Board of Regents.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Education**

3 (c) The Board of Regents consists of [17] 18 members as follows:

4 (1) (i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, one
5 VOTING member shall be a full-time student in good academic standing at an
6 institution under the jurisdiction of the Board.7 (ii) A student member who is in good academic standing at the
8 University of Maryland University College shall be exempt from the full-time
9 student requirement in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph.10 (2) One VOTING member shall be the State Secretary of Agriculture ex
11 officio; [and]12 (3) ONE NONVOTING MEMBER SHALL BE THE STATE TREASURER EX
13 OFFICIO; AND14 [(3)] (4) The remaining VOTING members of the Board shall be residents
15 of the State and shall be appointed from the general public.16 (d) In making appointments to the Board, the Governor shall consider
17 representation from all parts of the State.18 (e) Except for the Secretary of Agriculture AND THE STATE TREASURER, each
19 member of the Board shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent
20 of the Senate.21 (f) (1) Except for the student member, each appointed member serves for a
22 term of 5 years from July 1 of the year of appointment and until a successor is
23 appointed and qualifies. These members may be reappointed.24 (2) The student member shall be appointed for a term of 1 year, from
25 July 1, and may be reappointed if the student remains a student at any campus of the
26 University System of Maryland.27 (3) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves
28 only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.29 (g) Except for the Secretary of Agriculture AND THE STATE TREASURER, a
30 member may not serve more than 2 consecutive full terms.31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
32 effect October 1, 2002.
