A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Home Inspectors - Professional Development Requirements

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a licensed home inspector to complete certain
- 4 professional development instruction, and to submit certain evidence of
- 5 compliance with the requirement, to qualify for renewal of the license;
- 6 authorizing the State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers and Home
- 7 Inspectors to provide by regulation for exceptions to the professional
- 8 development requirement; requiring the Commission to approve the form and
- 9 subject matter of, the entities that may offer, and the methods of conducting the
- professional development courses; requiring the issuance of a certain certificate
- of completion; providing that this Act does not limit the authority of the

- certain circumstances; and generally relating to professional development

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions** 2 16-3A-07. 3 (a) Unless a license is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section, 4 the license expires on a staggered basis as determined by the Secretary. 5 At least 1 month before a license expires, the Commission shall mail to the (b) 6 licensee, at the last known address of the licensee: 7 a renewal application form; and (1) 8 (2) a notice that states: 9 (i) the date on which the current license expires; and 10 (ii) the amount of the renewal fee. 11 Before a license expires, the licensee may renew it for an additional 2-year (c) 12 term, if the licensee: 13 otherwise is entitled to be licensed: (1) pays to the Commission a renewal fee not to exceed \$400; [and] 14 (2)15 submits a renewal application on the form that the Commission (3)16 provides; AND SUBMITS TO THE COMMISSION ADEQUATE EVIDENCE OF 17 18 COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENT OF § 19 16-3A-09 OF THIS SUBTITLE. 20 The Commission shall renew the license of and issue a license to each 21 licensee who meets the requirements of this section.

- 23 (A) TO QUALIFY FOR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE AS A HOME INSPECTOR
- 24 UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A LICENSEE SHALL COMPLETE AT LEAST 15 CLOCK HOURS
- 25 OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT INSTRUCTION, AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION,
- 26 DURING THE PRECEDING 2-YEAR LICENSE TERM.
- THE COMMISSION BY REGULATION MAY PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS TO 27 28 THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENT OF THIS SECTION.
- 29 THE COMMISSION SHALL APPROVE THE FORM AND SUBJECT MATTER OF
- 30 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COURSES FOR HOME INSPECTORS REQUIRED UNDER
- 31 THIS SECTION.

- 1 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL APPROVE THE ENTITIES THAT MAY CONDUCT
- 2 THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COURSES FOR HOME INSPECTORS AND THE
- 3 METHODS OF CONDUCTING THEM.
- 4 (D) ON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
- 5 COURSE BY A LICENSEE, THE ENTITY THAT CONDUCTED THE COURSE OR THE
- 6 INSTRUCTOR SHALL ISSUE TO THE LICENSEE A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION THAT
- 7 STATES THE NUMBER OF CLOCK HOURS OF THAT COURSE.
- 8 (E) THIS SECTION DOES NOT LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF THE COMMISSION TO
- 9 REQUIRE ADDITIONAL EDUCATION, TRAINING, OR EXPERIENCE AS NECESSARY TO
- 10 ENSURE THE COMPETENCY OF LICENSED HOME INSPECTORS.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 2002.
