5 (A) THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE HARFORD COMMUNITY COLLEGE
6 BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PILOT PROGRAM IS BASED ON THE FINDINGS AND
7 POLICIES IN THIS SECTION.

8 (B) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY INTENDS TO CREATE AN INNOVATIVE MEANS
9 TO INCREASE ACCESS TO BACCALAUREATE DEGREE LEVEL EDUCATION IN AREAS
10 THAT MEET THE GOALS OF THE STATE PLAN FOR HIGHER EDUCATION AND FOR
11 PERSONS WHOSE CIRCUMSTANCES RESTRICT THEIR ACCESS TO BACCALAUREATE

3 (F) "HEAT CENTER" MEANS THE HIGHER EDUCATION APPLIED TECHNOLOGY 4 CENTER.

5 (G) "PILOT PROGRAM" MEANS THE HARFORD COMMUNITY COLLEGE 6 BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PILOT PROGRAM.

7 (H) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

9 (A) THERE IS A HARFORD COMMUNITY COLLEGE BACCALAUREATE DEGREE 10 PILOT PROGRAM.

(B) THE COLLEGE SHALL MAINTAIN THE MISSION AND POLICIES OF A
